**Product Description:** Mouse recombinant monoclonal antibody raised against human TNF alpha.

**Immunogen:** Original antibody is raised against by affinity maturation from the 2SD4 scFv, which in turn was selected on human TNF alpha by guided phage-display technology, using the murine anti-hTNF alpha antibody Mab32 as a template.

**Specificity:** Binds to soluble TNF-alpha, but not to lymphotoxin (TNF beta).

**Storage Instruction:** Store at 4°C for up to 3 months. For longer storage, aliquot and store at -20°C.

**Gene Summary:** This gene encodes a multifunctional proinflammatory cytokine that belongs to the tumor necrosis factor (TNF) superfamily. This cytokine is mainly secreted by macrophages. It can bind to, and thus functions through its receptors TNFRSF1A/TNFR1 and TNFRSF1B/TNFR2. This cytokine is involved in the

regulation of a wide spectrum of biological processes including cell proliferation, differentiation, apoptosis, lipid metabolism, and coagulation. This cytokine has been implicated in a variety of diseases, including autoimmune diseases, insulin resistance, and cancer. Knockout studies in mice also suggested the neuroprotective function of this cytokine. [provided by RefSeq]
