**Storage Buffer:** In 50mM Tris-Glycine, pH 7.4, (0.15M NaCl, 40% Glycerol, 0.01% Sodium azide and 0.05% BSA)

**Storage Instruction:** Store at 4°C. For longer storage, aliquot and store at -20°C.

Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

**Gene Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene is a subunit of a disulfide-linked homotrimeric protein. This protein is an adhesive glycoprotein that mediates cell-to-cell and cell-to-matrix interactions. This protein can bind to fibrinogen, fibronectin, laminin, type V collagen and integrins alpha-V/beta-1. This protein has been shown to play roles in platelet aggregation, angiogenesis, and tumorigenesis. [provided by RefSeq]
