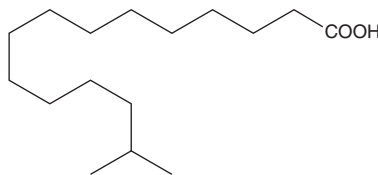

### Description

14-methyl Pentadecanoic acid is a branched-chain fatty acid that has been found in soil bacteria.<sup>1,2</sup>
