

Laboratory Procedures

4-Hydroxyphenylacetylglycine is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the 4-hydroxyphenylacetylglycine in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. 4-Hydroxyphenylacetylglycine is soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide. The solubility of 4-hydroxyphenylacetylglycine in these solvents is approximately 12, 11, and 14 mg/ml, respectively.

Further dilutions of the stock solution into aqueous buffers or isotonic saline should be made prior to performing biological experiments. Ensure that the residual amount of organic solvent is insignificant, since organic solvents may have physiological effects at low concentrations. Organic solvent-free aqueous solutions of 4-hydroxyphenylacetylglycine can be prepared by directly dissolving the solid in aqueous buffers. The solubility of 4-hydroxyphenylacetylglycine in PBS (pH 7.2) is approximately 0.5 mg/ml. We do not recommend storing the aqueous solution for more than one day.

Description

4-Hydroxyphenylacetylglycine is a metabolite of tyramine (Item No. 18601), a tyrosine-derived endogenous monoamine.1
