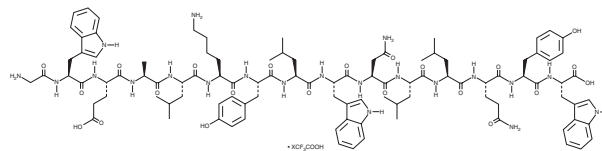

Laboratory Procedures

F9170 (trifluoroacetate salt) is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the F9170 (trifluoroacetate salt) in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. F9170 (trifluoroacetate salt) is soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide (DMF). The solubility of F9170 (trifluoroacetate salt) in ethanol and DMF is approximately 25 mg/ml and approximately 10 mg/ml and DMSO.

Description

F9170 is an antiviral peptide corresponding to amino acids 789-803 of the HIV-1 envelope glycoprotein.¹ It binds to the LLP1 domain within the HIV-1 envelope protein cytoplasmic tail and inhibits HIV-1 IIIB infection of MT-2 cells ($EC_{50} = 0.19 \mu\text{M}$). F9170 (3 mg/kg) reduces plasma viral load in a rhesus macaque model of simian HIV (SHIV) infection.
