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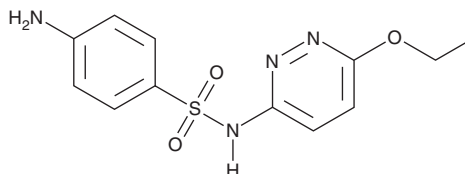

Laboratory Procedures

Sulfaethoxypyridazine is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the sulfaethoxypyridazine in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Sulfaethoxypyridazine is sparingly soluble (1-10 mg/ml) in DMSO.

Description

Sulfaethoxypyridazine is a sulfonamide antibiotic.¹ It is active against several strains of *E. coli* isolated from necropsied animals or poultry when used at concentrations of 0.25 or 1 mg/ml. Prolonged administration of sulfaethoxypyridazine (150 mg/kg for 13-27 weeks) induces the formation of cataracts in dogs.² Formulations containing sulfaethoxypyridazine have been used in the treatment of respiratory infections, foot rot, calf scours, and mastitis- or metritis-associated septicemia in cattle.
