Description

Interleukin-1 β (IL-1 β) is a pro-inflammatory cytokine that is produced by monocytes, macrophages, and dendritic cells (DCs). IL-1 β signals through the IL-1 receptor, type 1 (IL-1R1) to activate the myeloid differentiation primary response 88 (MYD88) signaling pathway, which contains the cytoplasmic Toll/IL-1 receptor (TIR) domain adapter. IL-1 β and the independently regulated IL-1 α protein have overlapping proinflammatory activities to induce adhesion molecule expression on epithelial cells, control fever induction, initiate rheumatoid arthritis, and promote septic shock.

This product is produced with no animal derived raw products. All processing and handling employs animal free equipment and animal free protocols.

Preparation and Storage

Reconstitution Centrifuge vial before opening. When reconstituting the product, gently pipet and wash down the sides of the

vial to ensure full recovery of the protein into solution. It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized

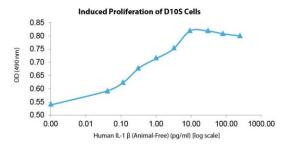
product with sterile water at 0.1 mg/ml, which can be further diluted into other aqueous solutions.

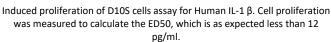
Stability and Storage 12 months from date of receipt when stored at -20°C to -80°C as supplied.

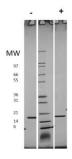
1 month when stored at 4°C after reconstituting as directed.
