Sodium/hydrogen exchanger 1 Blocking Peptide

BACKGROUND

NHE-1 is involved in pH regulation to eliminate acids generated by active metabolism or to counter adverse environmental conditions. Major proton extruding system driven by the inward sodium ion chemical gradient. NHE -1 plays an important role in signal transduction. Located in the kidney and intestine.

CUSTOMER STORAGE

Product should be stored at -20°C.
Aliquot to avoid freeze/thaw cycles

FORMULATION

Provided as solution in phosphate buffered saline

SHIP CONDITIONS

Ship at ambient temperature, freeze upon arrival

STABILITY

Products are stable for one year from purchase when stored properly

COMMENTS

For use with NHE1 polyclonal antibodies (Cat. No. X2315P & X2338P).

INSTRUCTIONS

Incubate antibody neat with at least a 50 fold stoichiometric excess of blocking peptide at 37 deg C for 20 minutes (molecular weights of peptide and antibody are ~2.5 kDa and ~160 kDa, respectively). Antibody can then be diluted to a concentration suitable for Western blot.

Example: 10 μ l or 10 μ g of Exalpha's rabbit anti-NHE1 (Cat. No. X2338P) is added to 10 μ g of blocking peptide for a total volume of 20 μ l. The mixture is allowed to incubate for 20 minutes at 37 deg C prior to dilution in suitable buffer (for Western blot, etc.).
