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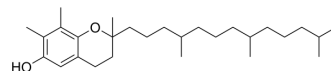

Description	(±)-γ-Tocopherol is an endogenous metabolite present in Blood that can be used for the research of Prostate Cancer and Endometrial Cancer <sup>[1][2][3]</sup> .
In Vitro	Endogenous metabolites is defined as those that are annotated by Kyoto Encyclopedia of Genes and Genomes as substrates or products of the ~1900 metabolic enzymes encoded in our genome. It is clear in the body of literature that there are documented toxic properties for many of these metabolites <sup>[1]</sup> . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods.
