Description	Felzartamab (MOR-202) is a human monoclonal antibody that targets CD38 and can be used in multiple myeloma research ^[1] [2].
In Vitro	The MOR202-mediated toxic effects on multiple myeloma (MM) cell lines can be enhanced by the proteasome inhibitor bortezomib (BOR) and the immunomodulator lenalidomide (LEN) ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
In Vivo	MOR202 can reduce osteolysis dose-dependently by up to 55% at 12 mg/kg. Co-administration with 0.6 mg/kg BOR or 50 mg/kg LEN at a low dose of 3 mg/kg completely eliminates osteolysis in mice MM model ^[1] . MCE has not independently confirmed the accuracy of these methods. They are for reference only.
