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#### Background

The reactivity of the antiserum is directed to the subclass IgG1. It does not react with other subclasses of IgG, IgG/Fab fragments, IgM and IgA or any non-Ig protein in mouse serum, as tested by immunoelectrophoresis and double radial immunodiffusion. In immunoelectrophoresis use 2  $\mu$ I or equivalent against 120  $\mu$ I antiserum. In double radial immunodiffusion (Ouchterlony) use a rosette arrangement with 10  $\mu$ I antiserum in a 3 mm diameter centre well and 2  $\mu$ I serum samples (neat and diluted) in 2 mm diameter peripheral wells.

#### Source

Pools of purified homogenous IgG1 isolated from mouse serum. Freund's complete adjuvant is used in the first step of the immunization procedure.

#### Product

Delipidated, heat inactivated, lyophilized, stable whole antiserum No preservative added, as it may interfere with the antibody activity. Total protein and IgG concentration in the antiserum are comparable to those of pooled normal goat serum. No foreign proteins added.

#### Applications

Immunoprecipitation.

#### **Cross Reactivity**

This antiSerum is not species-specific since inter-species crossreactivity is a normal feature of antisera to immunoglobulins. Cross-reactivity has not been tested in detail, however in double radial diffusion a reaction with Rat ha been observed.

Specificity

Precipitating polyclonal Goat antiSerum to Mouse IgG1, subclass specific

#### Storage

The lyophilized antiserum is shipped at ambient temperature and may be stored at +4°C; prolonged storage at or below -20°C. Reconstitute the lyophilized antiserum by adding 1 ml sterile distilled water. Dilutions may be prepared by adding phosphate buffered saline (PBS, pH 7.2). Repeated thawing and freezing should be avoided. If a slight precipitation occurs upon storage, this should be removed by centrifugation. It will not affect the performance of the antiserum. Diluted antiserum should be stored at +4°C, not refrozen, and preferably used the same day. Lyophilized at +4° C--at least 10 years. Reconstituted at or below -20° C--3-5 years. Reconstituted at +4° C--7 days
