### Background

Cardiotin is a high molecular weight protein complex (300 kDa) located in the mitochondria of cardiomyocytes and skeletal muscle. The cardiotin structure exists of subunits of 60 kDa and 100 kDa, probably in a tetrameric configuration. Both subunits contain the same amino-terminal 14 amino-acid sequence, showing high homology to Human skeletal muscle  $\alpha$ -actinin. During cardiac contractile dysfunction and myocardial cell differentiation, the cardiotin distribution is affected. Compared to other structural proteins, cardiotin is one of the first to respond to insults (ischemia, fibrillation) that influence the functional status of cardiomyocytes.

### Source

SR-3 is a Mouse monoclonal IgM antibody derived by fusion of SP2/0-Ag14 Mouse myeloma cells with spleen cells from a BALB/c Mouse immunized with the 100 kDa cardiotin subunit.

### Product

Each vial contains 100  $\mu$ l 1 mg/ml purified monoclonal antibody in PBS containing 0.09% sodium azide.

### Applications

SR-3 is useful for immunohistochemistry on frozen sections and immunoblotting. In immunoblotting assays SR-3 reacts with the 300 kDa cardiotin protein complex and its 100 kDa and 60 kDa subunits. Optimal antibody dilution should be determined by titration; recommended range is 1:100 – 1:200 for immunohistochemistry with avidin-biotinylated Horseradish peroxidase complex (ABC) as detection reagent, and 1:100 – 1:500 for immunoblotting applications.

**Specificity**

SR-3 reacts with cardiotin, a mitochondrion-associated protein, which is present in cardiomyocytes and skeletal muscle, but also in epithelial cells and tissues.

**Storage**

Store at 4°C, or in small aliquots at -20°C.
