| Background:        | Secreted as part of the adaptive immune response by plasma B cells, immunoglobulin G constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins. Immunoglobulin G binds to viruses, bacteria, as well as fungi and facilitates their destruction or neutralization via agglutination (and thereby immobilizing them), activation of the compliment cascade, and opsinization for phagocytosis. This antibody possesses the F(c) region, recognized by high-affinity Fc receptor proteins. |

### **Target Details**

**Purity/Specificity:** This product was prepared from normal serum by a multi-step process which includes

delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography and papain digestion followed by chromatographic separation and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Goat Serum, anti-Goat IgG and anti-Goat IgG F(c). No reaction was observed against anti-Goat IgG F(ab')2 or anti-Papain.




