Section 8 - Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled **Wear respirator, chemical safety goggles, rubber boots and heavy rubber gloves. Sweep up, place in a bag and hold for waste disposal. Avoid raising dust. Ventilate area and wash spill site after material pickup is complete.**

Waste Disposal Method **Burn in a Chemical Incinerator equipped with an Afterburner & Scrubber. Observe all Federal, State & Local Laws when disposing of any waste.**

Precautions to Be Taken in Handling and Storage **Keep tightly closed. Handle & store under nitrogen. Moisture sensitive. freeze, avoid repeated exposure. Keep away from combustible materials, heat sparks & open flame. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not breathe vapor.**
