Inhalation:

Remove to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.

Skin:

Immediately flush skin with copious amounts of water for at least 15 min while removing contaminated clothing and shoes.

Ingestion:

If swallowed, wash out mouth with water provided person is conscious. Call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing immediately.

Eves:

Immediately flush eyes with copious amounts of water for at least 15 min. Assure adequate flushing by separating the evelids with fingers. Call a physician.

Section 8 - Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled:

Wear respirator, chemical safety goggles, rubber boots and heavy rubber gloves. Sweep up, place in a bag and hold for waste disposal. Avoid raising dust.

Waste Disposal Method:

Dissolve or mix the material with a combustible solvent and burn in a chemical incinerator equipped with an afterburner and scrubber. Observe all federal, state and local environmental regulations.

Keep tightly closed. Store in a cool dry place. Possible mutagen. Irritant.
